The Children's Fund provides basic necessities for many of our disadvantaged public school children. Through your generosity, these students are afforded the opportunity for a more successful learning experience.

Since the inception of The Children's Fund, granted requests have exceeded \$300,000 to assist Connecticut's public school children in precarious situations, including the following examples.

- A student is afflicted with a degenerative muscular condition and must take a van to school. He needed a special transport chair to be able to get on the bus. Insurance would not pay for the device and his parents couldn't afford it. CEF funds paid for the chair so that the student could attend school and special programs.

- A student has cystic fibrosis and needs costly medication to survive. One of the medications she must take costs her mother \$600 per month, in addition to the costs for other medications. CEF provided funds to help defray the cost of these medications.

- A family came to America from a refugee camp in Thailand with only the clothes on their backs. CEF provided clothing so that the children would be able to attend school.

Your support is vital in CEF's efforts to help children who persevere in unmanageable situations. Your involvement in this event will, indeed, make a difference in a child's life.

DIRECTIONS TO GLASTONBURY HILLS

From South of Hartford

Take I-91 North to Exit 25, Rt. 3 North. After going over the bridge, bear right on Rt. 2 East. Follow Rt. 2 to Exit 10, Manchester Road. At the end of the ramp turn right. At the stop sign turn left. At the next stop sign turn right onto Country Club Road. Glastonbury Hills is at the end of this road on the right.

From Hartford and East

Take I-84 to Exit 55, Route 2 East. Follow Rt. 2 to Exit 10, Manchester Road. At the end of the ramp turn right. At the stop sign turn left. At the next stop sign turn right onto Country Club Road. Glastonbury Hills is at the end of this road on the right.

From North of Hartford

Take I-91 South to I-84 East (left-hand Exit). Follow I-84 to Exit 55, Rt. 2 East. Follow Rt. 2 to Exit 10, Manchester Road. At the end of the ramp turn right. At the stop sign turn left. At the next stop sign turn right onto Country Club Road. Glastonbury Hills is at the end of this road on the right.
