

CT-SEDS Fix-It Forums

The Connecticut State Department of Education is hosting a series of 90-minute forums to hear directly from you about the state's new IEP document and special education data system (CT-SEDS). This is a direct result of CEA's advocacy on behalf of our members.

CT-SEDS, used primarily by special education teachers, speech-language pathologists, school psychologists, social workers, and counselors, has been fraught with technical failures, inadequate training and help desk support, and significant burdens added to an already heavy workload for educators. While some of these issues have been addressed, much more work needs to be done.

Come share your suggestions and experiences with the SDE so that the agency has a clear picture of what it's like to work with the new system and how it can be improved. Your feedback is key to getting the right changes, training, and support.
