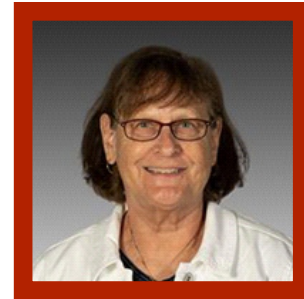
MAUREEN HONAN

Maureen Honan was elected to the State Teachers' Retirement Board in November 2011 and served on the Appeals, Audit and Health Care Committees until her retirement in 2017.

As an educator for 41 years in Region 15, serving the towns of Middlebury and Southbury, she began her career as a fifth grade teacher, then as a special educator at the secondary level and finishing as an administrator. As an active teacher, she was President of the Pomperaug Education Association. For 34 years, she negotiated contracts focusing on health care, contract language and salary benefits both at the teacher and administrator levels.

While in Washington DC as NEA Director she lobbied The CT Congressional Delegation on GPO/WEP and issues pertaining to education and health care.
