

YOU LOSE WITHOUT YOUR UNION

Don't be fooled by anti-union groups saying you have nothing to lose by leaving your union.

By revoking your membership in your local Association, Connecticut Education Association, and National Education Association, you will

- X LOSE** your ability to vote on contract ratifications, serve on your local bargaining team, or provide any input into negotiations of your local Association contract.
- X LOSE** free legal services for DCF investigations, termination or tenure claims, workers compensation, unemployment claims, or certification issues.
- X LOSE** \$1 million employment liability insurance. If you are sued for events in the workplace, you will be responsible for your own legal defense and payment of any judgment.
- X LOSE** free retirement consultation services and certification consultation services.
- X LOSE** the ability to attend trainings or professional development sponsored by the local Association, CEA, or NEA.
- X LOSE** up to \$35,000 reimbursement for legal fees/costs from the Educators Employment Liability insurance program for the defense of criminal proceedings arising out of allegations of corporal punishment or, if exonerated, regarding other criminal allegations.
- X LOSE** member benefits and services including CEA members-only discounts, such as auto insurance discounts, homeowners insurance, and more.

Stick with your union and stand strong with your colleagues as members of CEA to ensure higher wages, better benefits, and good working conditions.
